1- “JETRAVILLE!”: A NEW JOB OFFER BOARD

Many of you registered for the temporary job-posting Web platform to fill your urgent needs for workers, and the statistical data indicates heavy traffic on the platform.

However, the Ministère du Travail, de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale (MTESS) is replacing the temporary platform by a job-offer bulletin board that is more efficient for users. Under the name “*Jetravaille!*,” the site is now up and running for employers to allow them to register their job offers, through to June 9, 2020. During this time, job seekers can continue consulting the job offers posted on the temporary Web platform.

A team from the MTESS plans to make personalized calls to businesses that are currently displaying job offers on the temporary platform to ask them to transfer their offers to the “*Jetravaille!*” website.

Employers wishing to maintain their job offers and all those in need of workers are asked to post their offers, effective immediately, on “*Jetravaille!*” at the following address:
